Aromas of dark chocolate and coffee... tobacco-leaf and blackcurrant... cigar box and spice... spicy plum and blueberry.

The palate follows with fleshy, ripe, red and blackberry flavours, a gorgeous creamy texture, and some toasty spicy oak.

There's nothing better than rich, dark chocolate and dense blackcurrant with a touch of mint rounded out by some stylish French oak. Add a touch of red-berried Merlot to flesh it out and *cabernet merlot by brad* is hard to beat.

With fruit sourced from both southern and northern Margaret River vineyards we reckon this is pretty smart stuff. Cab Merlot is classy says *brad*.

Consistency and quality seem to be Wine by Brad's mantra – every wine I've tried from this label so far has been impressive. A gold-medal winner, it has pretty, complex aromas of red and blackcurrant along with the dusty and bay-leaf aromas often found in Margaret River reds. Medium-bodied flavours of blackberry, blackcurrant, plum, chocolate and tobacco have loads of complexity and were even better after being opened a day. It's well-structured and finishes with lengthy cocoa and dark berry flavours.
