## 2011 Semillon Sauvignon Blanc

Pungent grassy Margaret River Sem Sav bounces out of the glass, followed by citrus aromas, pineapple, guava and smoky spice. A creamy palate with gorgeous lemony richness is balanced neatly by zippy, zesty freshness.

This wine has the usual fresh tropical pineapple and passionfruit elements, wrapped neatly in scrummy citrus flavours, providing the purrrfect summer cleanser. Cool for cats.

The ultimate Margaret River white from the ultimate Margaret River vintage. Wow! You know you love it. Go on – treat yourself – grab a bottle and pour yourself a big glass.

The fruit for this vintage was split evenly between cooler southern Margaret River vineyards and a warmer northern block around Yallingup. It shows the cool and classy characters this blend is renowned for. Get into it!
